Michigan Colored Pencil 2010 is a 100% colored pencil art exhibition, open to all members of CPSA Detroit District Chapter #104 and all Michigan artists.

Eligibility:

Artist must be 18 or over and a resident of Michigan or a member of CPSA Detroit #104.

Artists may submit up to three 2-dimensional, original works of art, completed within the last three years that have not been shown previously in CPSA exhibits. Digital jpeg images (not to exceed 2 MB) can be emailed to Diane Radtke at rradtke01@comcast.net or a CD mailed to Diane at 54349 Horizon Drive, Shelby township, MI 48316. Deadline is February 20, 2010.

Concept, design, and execution of the artwork shall be solely that of the artist. No work copied from copyrighted or published materials. No images produced by drawing over a digital reproduction allowed.

Specifications:

Must be **100% colored pencil** and each artwork cannot exceed 32"x 40" framed. Each artwork must have Plexiglas with a hook and eye/wire hanger.

Entry Fees:

Entry fees are \$10.00 per picture for up to three pieces entered for CPSA members and \$15.00 per picture for up to three pieces for non-CPSA members. Fees are due with entry form and image/s by the deadline. Please list artwork in order of preference for admittance into the exhibition.

Liability:

Artists are responsible for insuring their own artwork. CPSA#104 takes every precaution to protect all artwork; however, Lotus Arts Gallery or CPSA **will not** be responsible for artwork received in damaged condition or in the event of loss or damage to artwork submitted to this exhibit.

Artwork Identification:

Each artwork must be identified on the back (top right corner) by Artist, Artist's phone number, Title, Pricing.

Sale of Artwork

Prices will be marked (or NFS) on artworks. Lotus Arts Gallery will take 100% payment and reimburse the artist 70%. All artwork must remain for the duration of the exhibition.

Selection of Submitted Artwork

Artwork not meeting specifications will be declined and must be picked up by the artist. Award winners will be notified by telephone by March 6, 2010 and will be posted on the website.

Juror — Amy Foster

Amy Foster is a 1994 graduate of the Center for Creative Studies - College of Art and Design in Detroit where she received her Bachelor of Fine Arts degree while majoring in illustration. In 1999, she returned to CCS to teach through their continuing education program and is currently teaching Drawing through their Foundations Department. In addition to CCS, Amy is also currently teaching through the Birmingham Bloomfield Art Center and through her own home studio.

Amy's love for anything related to the figure allows her to spend the majority of her teaching time instructing classes on the Portrait, Figure, Costumed Figure, and Anatomy for Artists although she also teaches Still Life Drawing classes that cover basic drawing principles and general color theory.

BUILDING BLOCKS OF COLOR

with Bonnie Auten, CPSCA

If you have wished you could paint with your pencils, this is your chance to experience that feeling of freedom on a fast and efficient surface that is so forgiving it makes worrying about mistakes a very rare occurrence. Bonnie will teach how to use water-soluble crayons to speed up the painting process.

Many Colored Pencil artists are not sure how to use the newer water-soluble crayons (*Caran d'Ache-Neocolor* and *Lyra Aquacolor*). This Workshop explores the many uses and techniques of mixing, creating a palette, and layering over and under colored pencil, using water-soluble crayons. You'll learn how to use the crayons extensively to lay in a wash that is then layered with colored pencils.

Coloursoft, *Polychromos* and possibly *Lyra* and *Pablo* pencils are all very useful for this fast and free technique. Rather than the waxy Prismacolor pencils, these dryer and softer pencils are used to their fullest extent. As they are all partial or fully water-soluble, they can be layered over and under the washes to create intense color and strong effects. In this workshop you learn to blend with a brush and with water to create smooth color transitions.

UArt paper is utilized throughout the exercises, as it is very forgiving, will not buckle when wet, and is almost indestructible. Bonnie will also touch on how colors work together, their psychological effects, warm and cool tones, and value scale.
